5. How can you reflect the light of Jesus to those in your home, work, relationships?
6. When you go about your day, do people see Joy in and around you? Have you found Joy in sharing the love of Jesus with others?
7. What are some words you treasure about Jesus? What does Jesus being born mean to you personally?
8. Is there a part of your life where you are not trusting God? Is it keeping you from going beyond your own plans and dreams?
9. Why did Jesus come through such lowly and humble means? Are there areas of your life where it is difficult to be humble?
10. In what ways has God called you or your family to seek the lost? Are you willing to go to the hard places or be misunderstood in order to tell people that Jesus, OUR HOPE, is born?
11. How can we continue to trust God's goodness in seasons that may be difficult?
12. What does it mean for Jesus to be your Prince of Peace? What things or circumstances threaten to disrupt the peace you feel in your heart?
